Start signing up for the awards brunch and have cash of \$23 dollars on hand to give to Flora.

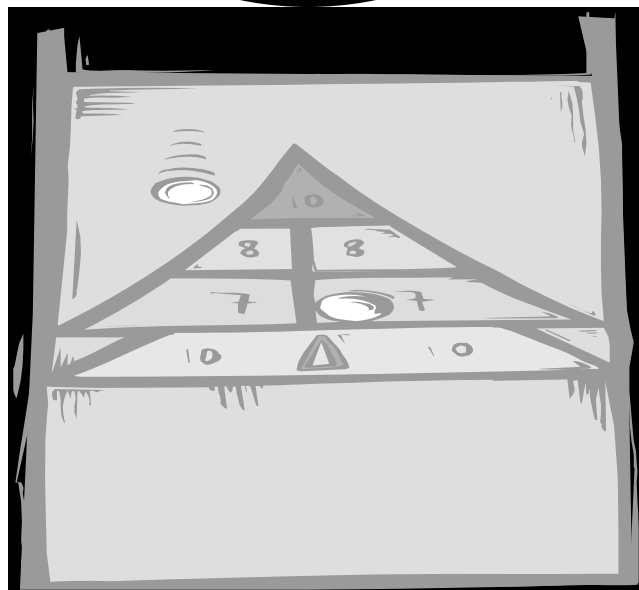
