Don Turner will be signing up all those who wish to place any bets and Parker (Sergeant at Arms) will be monitoring the placement of any bribes.

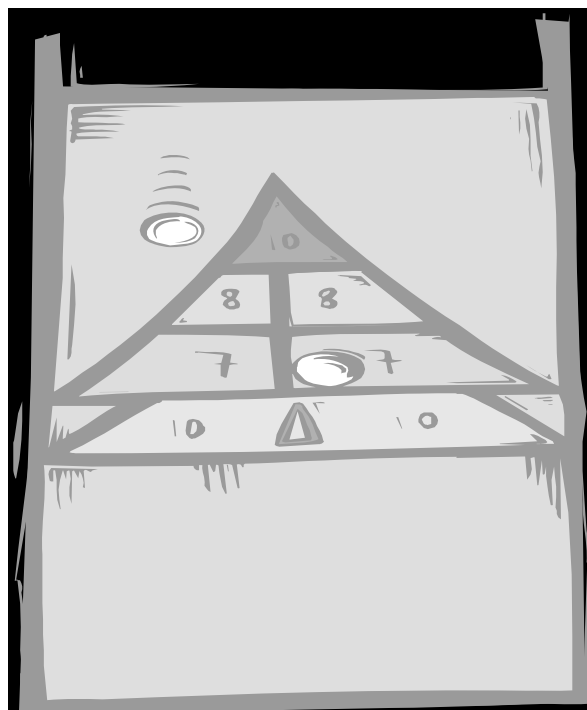
