Have a question “Who was Dick and Hy’s partners last year?”.

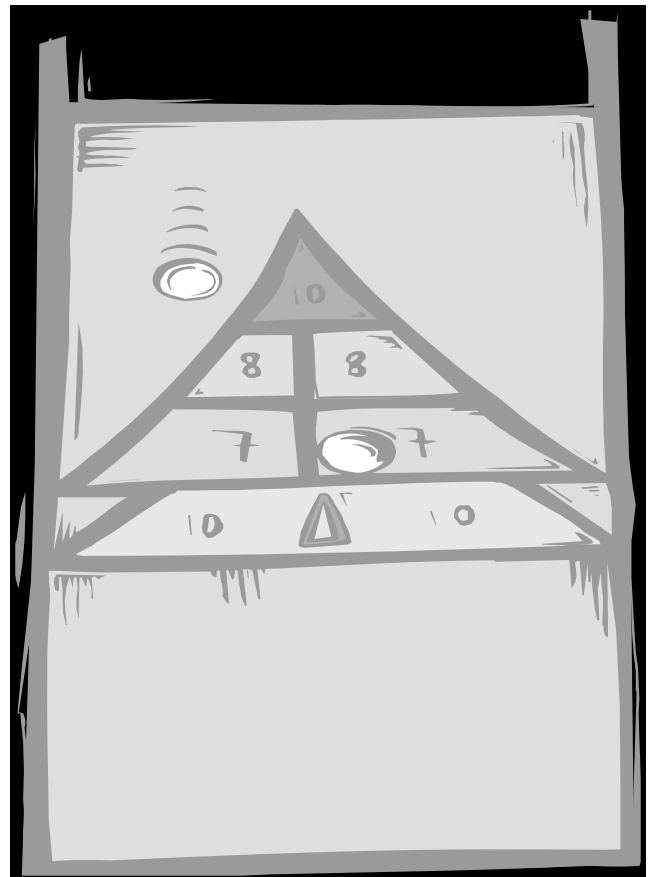
The sign up sheet being prepared by Carole Green will be at the Shack tomorrow afternoon.
