**GUIDELINES FOR THE  
MKV SHUFFLEBOARD  
TOURNAMENT 2007.**

- 1) Pucks touching the lines do not count, all others, including overhangs do count.
- 2) Scores will be tallied after all pucks come to rest, regardless of their journey.
- 3) Opinions rendered mid-play may result in penalties if the puck is moved during play.
- 4) No specimens are to be collected or supplied unless requested by an official.
- 5) Performance enhancing liquids ingested during a match may require sharing. Be forewarned! “So called Bruce Kranak Rule”.

6) Judges shall make every effort not to drink alcoholic beverages excessively during a match.

7) Who ever wins the coin toss gets to choose the color, or going first or second or which side but not all 3 choices.

There are many “Unwritten Rules” which may also be applied as needed from time to time.

These guidelines were formulated after careful consultation with Retired Judges and agreement of Judge Parker and Judge Joe.

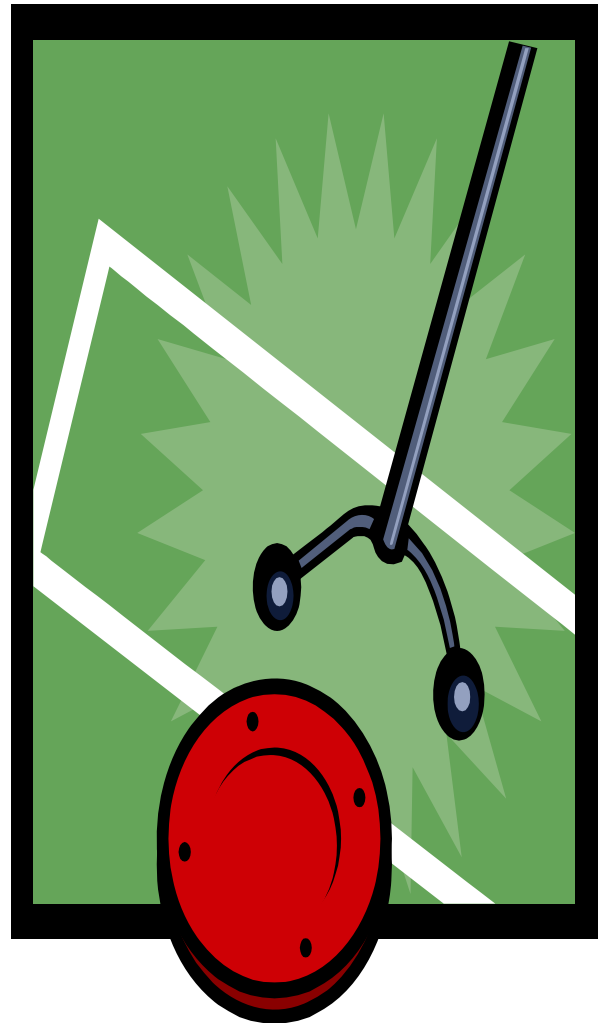
