2). The unwritten rules have been simplified, condensed and otherwise made more understandable.

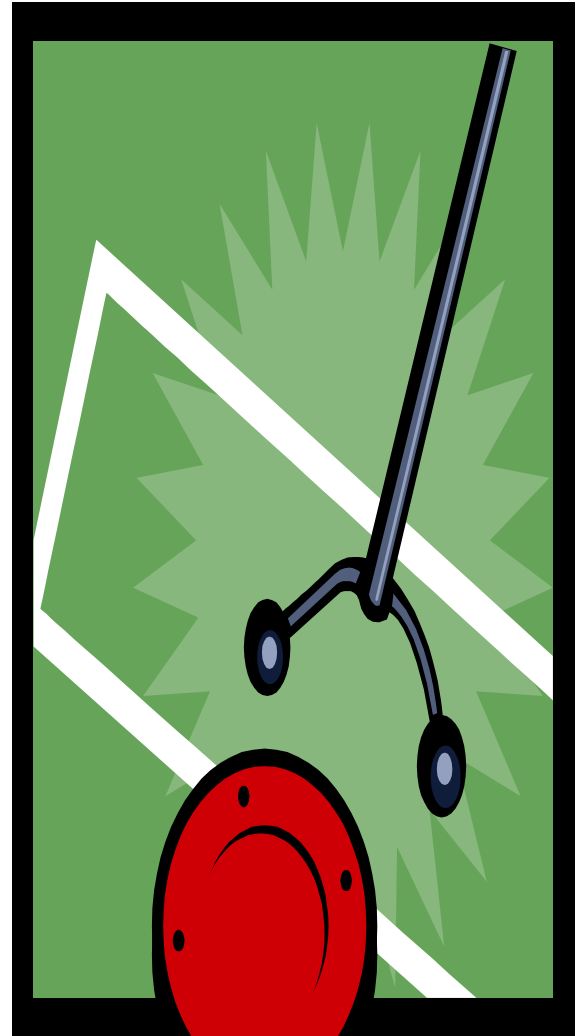
3). The Judges wish good luck to all players, especially those players who appreciate their monetary needs.
