The Yellow pucks would be good for those who will not play. What do you think?.

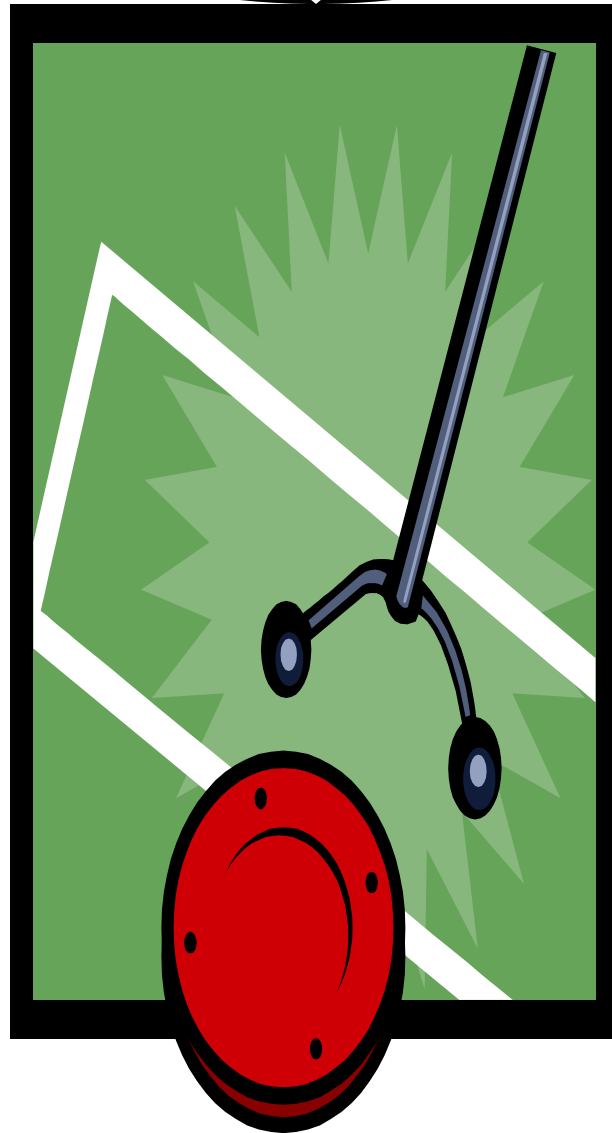
