We saw why Jim Roemer retired from the Board, his new profession being leaf remover for MKV Shuffleboard Tournaments. Good Work Jim!.

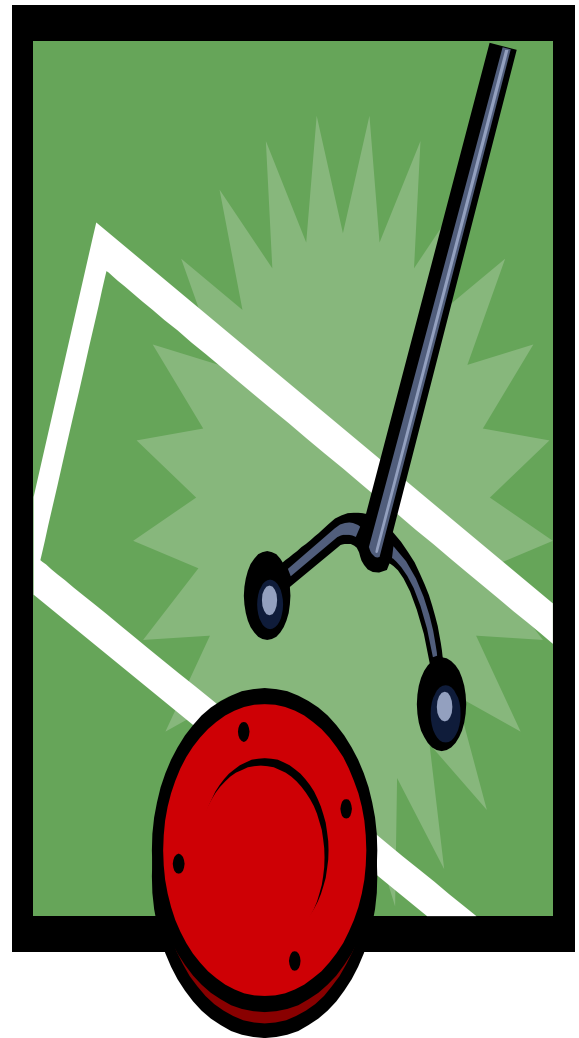
According to information from Mike Sands, the winning team will each receive a free stay for them and their better halves at the Aston Plantation Resort on Kauai.
