From Gene

Today's match seemed to surprise a lot of people. There were lots of minus tens and the game went a little longer than most. No one knows how long, but probably several days. This has been a unique game in two respects:

1) You may have noticed a storm hit. Along with the storm was a low pressure center off the coast. Low pressure centers cause many unexpected events. First - the low pressure reduces the surface tension on the court. This tends to cause pucks to "float". This takes pucks that otherwise would have been eights and floats them right into minus ten. As you could see, this phenomena affected all four very talented players.



2) A lesser know problem with low pressure is how it impacts the spinning of the earth. Low pressure tends to speed the rotation of the earth. This particularly happens when the low pressure center is not over land masses. In this case, it was over the Pacific. As a result, while many people thought the match was called after fifty six minutes, it was actually only 35.6 minutes. The precise computation is observed minutes divided by pi (3.14) times 2. 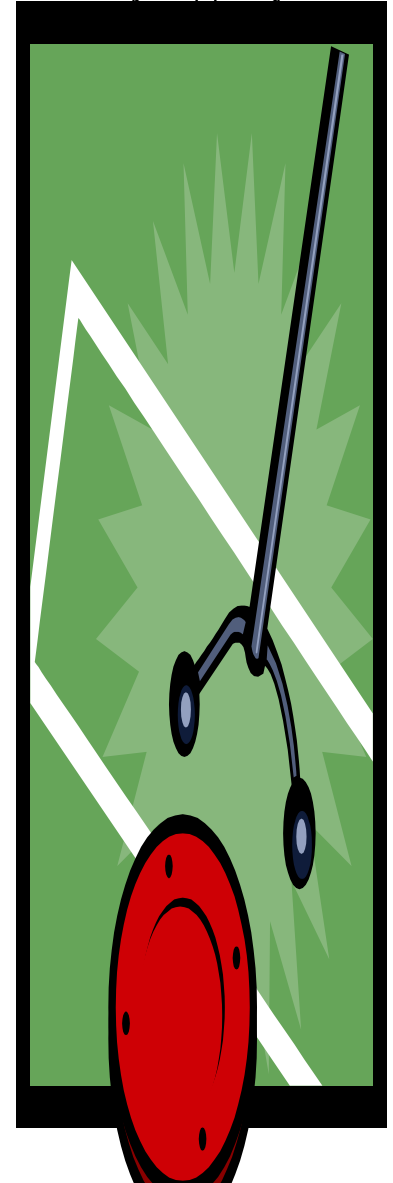
So let it be known, The players are exceptionally talented and the match is fairly short (so far).
