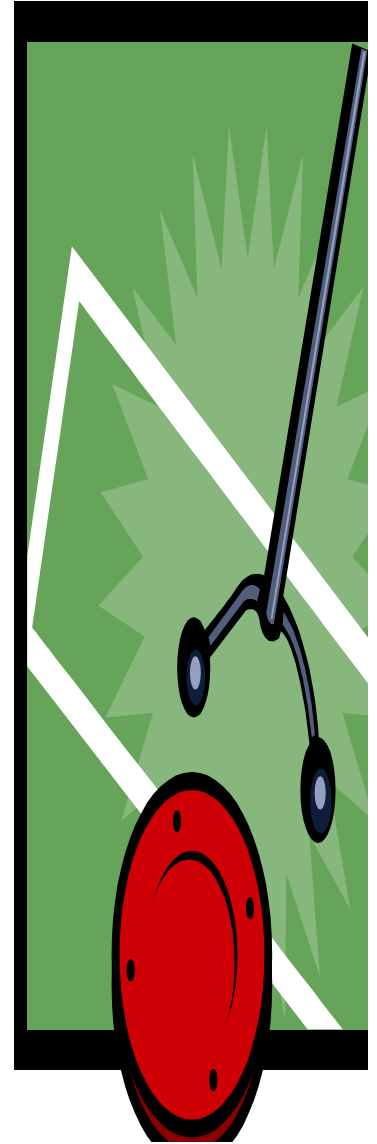
LATE EDITION WITH KEN'S USUAL SMILEY FACE EMOTICON..
