The Grand Prize to each 1st placed winner is a “Free” Ride to the Airport. The ride from MKV to the airport is at the courtesy of

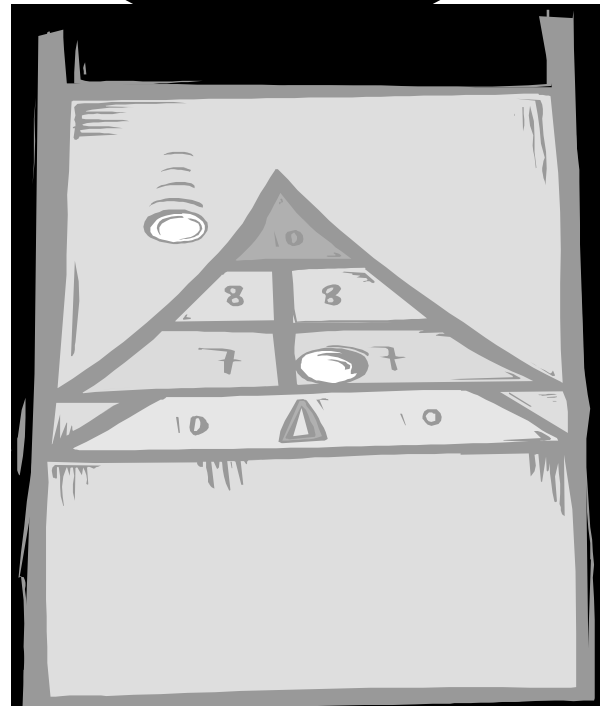
