The improvement to the Board is well noted by it's two new members.

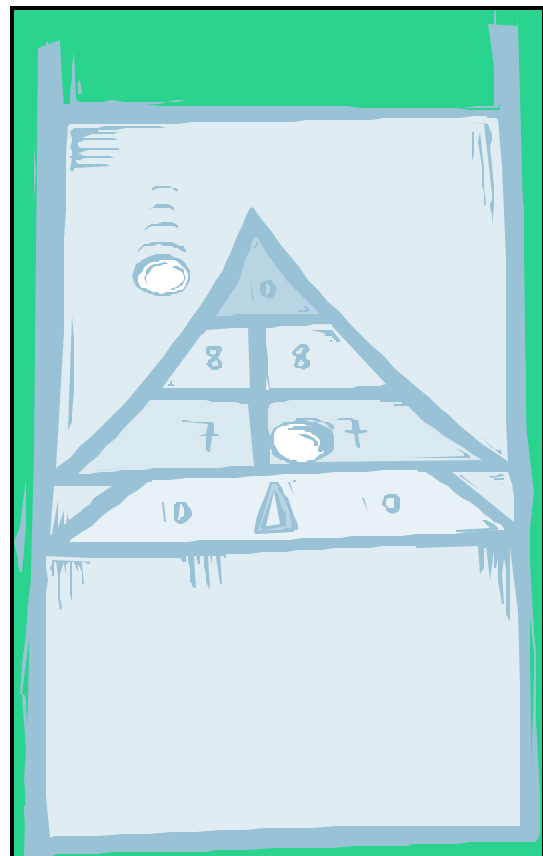
