Attached is the pairing for the matches. Wild Card play-in should begin Wednesday, Jan. 29th and be completed by Sunday, Feb. 2nd.

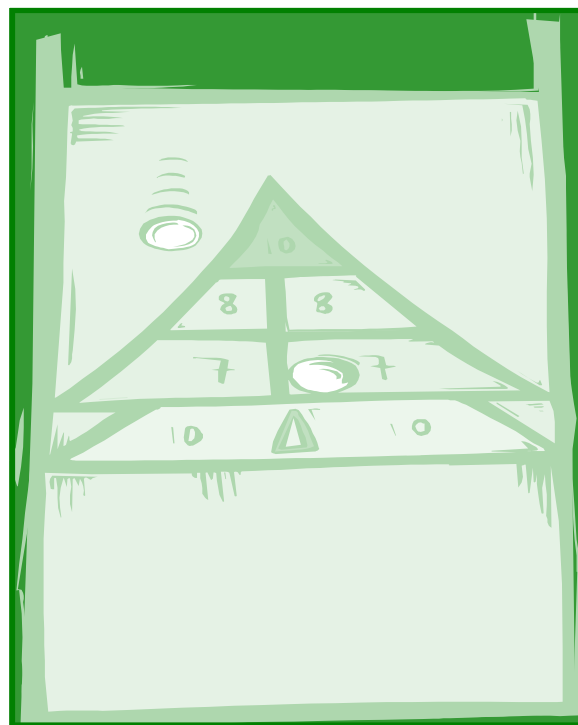
Next round to begin Monday, Feb. 3rd to be completed by Thursday, Feb. 9th.
