*Dr. Bill Green advised he had received several more specimens yesterday and today. The lab is working over-time and is inundated with work and staff are demanding a triple wage hike.*

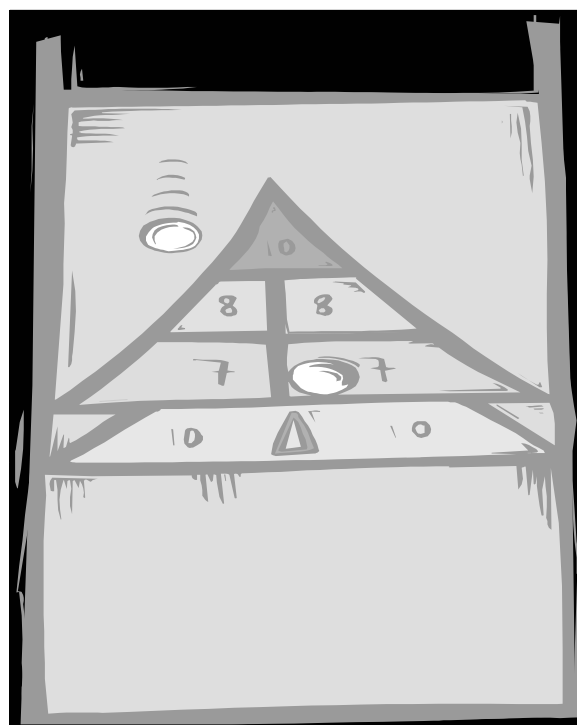
*Do come out to watch the games and spur on the competitors but remember no coaching from the sidelines allowed.*
